

Expected changes in management and controlling bodies

Juraj Šedivý will be appointed the new CEO and Chairman of the Board of Česká telekomunikační infrastruktura a.s. (CETIN), replacing current CEO Petr Slováček and Chairman Martin Vlček, from the start of the new year. This change intends to unify the roles of Chairman of the Board and CEO. Martin Vlček and Petr Slováček will join the Supervisory Board of CETIN and will continue to participate in telecommunication project within PPF Group. The third member of the new Supervisory Board will be a deputy elected by employees.

Petr Slováček and Martin Vlček have led CETIN since its incorporation three and half years ago. They made a fundamental contribution to the separation of the former O2 into two independent companies – CETIN, the infrastructure operator and O2, the retail operator providing telecommunication services to end users. They managed to establish the newly incorporated company as a stable wholesale operator, having developed business relations with all important participants in the Czech telecommunications market.

Juraj Šedivý has extensive international experience in telecommunications. Among his past roles, he was a member of the top management of Český Telecom, played part in the foundation of Telefónica O2 Slovakia and has led the company as CEO for the first three years.
